| 1. Networking | If you have an employer willing to sign you for an apprenticeship, we may be able save you a registration fee and help your employer access funding to help reduce the cost of training. See your guidance counsellor or co-op teacher and ask for a pre-registration form. | | | |

| 4. Apprenticeship | Mohawk College both offer apprenticeship courses leading to possible certification as a Child and Youth Worker. | | | |
| 5. CYW Concentrated OYAP | Requires Grade 12 college or university English. Concentrated OYAP students earn 4 secondary school co-op credits and 5 Mohawk College CYW courses in the same semester. If your employer agrees, you can pursue your CYW Certification through the Apprenticeship. | | | |
