Other Pathways to Apprenticeship				
1. Networking	If you have an employer willing to sign you for an apprenticeship, we may be able to help you access funding to help reduce the cost of training. See your Guidance counsellor or Co-op teacher and ask for a pre-registration form.			
2. Co-op	Exploratory Co-op possible in grade 11, Concentrated OYAP + Summer OYAP Co-op for a total of 6 Credits in the last semester of grade 12 @ GDHS. As an alternative to concentrated OYAP students may take a 4 Credit OYAP Co-op in Grade 12			
.3. Colleges	Mohawk College has a 1 year Certificate program designed to help you get an apprenticeship "Industrial Woodworking Techniques" (check www.ontariocolleges.ca) Conestoga also has a 2 year programs which can prepare you for the apprenticeship see "Woodworking Technician" (www.ontariocolleges.ca)			
6. Recommended Pathway " Concentrated OYAP "	Concentrated OYAP is similar to the one-year certificate Techniques program at college. Concentrated OYAP prepares you for academic success in the apprenticeship courses offered at College. Concentrated OYAP teachers will also assist you in finding a co-op placement that has the potential to become an apprenticeship.
