<b>Other Pathways to Apprenticeship</b>				
1. Networking	If you have an employer willing to sign you for an apprenticeship, we may be able save you a registration fee and help your employer access funding to help reduce the cost of training. <b>See your Guidance counsellor or Co-op teacher and ask for a pre-registration form.</b>			
2. Co-op	Exploratory Co-op possible in grade 11, <b>Concentrated OYAP + July OYAP Co-op for a total of 6 Credits in the last semester of grade 12 @ GDHS.</b> As an alternative to concentrated OYAP students may take a 4 Credit OYAP Co-op in Grade 12			
3. Colleges	Fanshawe College has a 1 year Certificate program designed to help you get an apprenticeship (check <a href="http://www.ontariocolleges.ca/pdf/college_guide.pdf">http://www.ontariocolleges.ca/pdf/college_guide.pdf</a> ) for full details. Fanshawe also has a 2 year programs which can prepare you for the apprenticeship see "Construction Engineering Technician"			
4. Pre-apprenticeship Programs	The Centre for Skills Development in Burlington also has a pre-apprenticeship construction program ( <a href="http://www.thecentre.on.ca">http://www.thecentre.on.ca</a> ) cost approximately \$ 6000
