| 2. Co-op | Exploratory Co-op possible in grade 11, Concentrated OYAP + July OYAP Co-op for a total of 6 Credits in the last semester of grade 12 @ GDHS. As an alternative to concentrated OYAP students may take a 4 Credit OYAP Co-op in Grade 12 | | | |
| 3. Colleges | Fanshawe College has a 1 year Certificate program designed to help you get an apprenticeship (check http://www.ontariocolleges.ca/pdf/college_guide.pdf) for full details. Fanshawe also has a 2 year programs which can prepare you for the apprenticeship see "Construction Engineering Technician" | | | |
