Other Pathways to Apprenticeship				
1. Networking	If you have an employer willing to sign you for an apprenticeship, we may be able save you a registration fee and help your employer access funding to help reduce the cost of training. See your Guidance counsellor or Co-op teacher and ask for a pre-registration form.			
2. Co-op	Exploratory Co-op is possible in grade 11, However Co-op is recommended after the 4 credit Chef Training Concentrated OYAP offered in the first semester of grade 12 or in year 5. As an alternative to concentrated OYAP students may take a 4 Credit OYAP Co-op in Grade 12.
