See your Guidance counsellor or Co-op teacher and ask for a pre-registration form.</p> <p>Exploratory Co-op possible in grade 11, Concentrated OYAP + Summer OYAP Co-op for a total of 6 Credits in the last semester of grade 12 @ Holy Trinity . As an alternative to concentrated OYAP students may take a 4 Credit OYAP Co-op in Grade 12</p> <p>Presently there are no 1 year programs at college designed to help you get an apprenticeship There are a number of 2 year programs which can prepare you for the apprenticeship see Electrical Engineering Technician at Mohawk. (check http://www.ontariocolleges.ca/pdf/college_guide.pdf).</p> <p>The Centre for Skills Development in Burlington also has a pre-apprenticeship electrical program (http://www.thecentre.on.ca) cost approximately \$ 6000</p> <p>Graduates can apply to one of the Electrical Trade Unions. (http://www.electricalapprenticeship.ca)</p> <p>Concentrated OYAP is similar to the one-year certificate program at the Centre for Skills Development.
