<b>Other Pathways to Apprenticeship</b>				
1. Networking	If you have an employer willing to sign you for an apprenticeship, we may be able save you a registration fee and help your employer access funding to help reduce the cost of training. <b>See your Guidance counsellor or Co-op teacher and ask for a pre-registration form.</b>			
2. Co-op	Exploratory Co-op recommended in grade 12, <b>Concentrated OYAP + OYAP Co-op for a total of 6 Credits in grade 12</b> , 4 in-school + at least 2 perhaps 4 Co-op.

4. Recommended Pathway	<b>Concentrated OYAP</b> students have the opportunity to earn both secondary school credits and Canadore College credits in the same semester. This Concentrated OYAP program is similar to the one-year certificate program at college or private vocational training centre. Concentrated OYAP prepares you for academic success in the apprenticeship courses offered at College, in addition students may earn an exemption from the first of the two levels of Apprenticeship Training at College. Concentrated OYAP teachers will also assist you in finding a co-op placement that has the potential to become an apprenticeship.
