Other Pathways to Apprenticeship				
1. Networking	If you have an employer willing to sign you for an apprenticeship, we may be able save you a registration fee and help your employer access funding to help reduce the cost of training. See your Guidance counsellor or Co-op teacher and ask for a pre-registration form.			
2. Co-op	Exploratory Co-op suggested in grade 11, plus Concentrated OYAP + OYAP Co-op for a total of 4 Credits in semester 2 of grade 12, As an alternative to concentrated OYAP students may take a 4 Credit OYAP Co-op in Grade 12			
3. Pre-apprenticeship Programs	Mohawk College offers a pre-apprenticeship Certificate program "Motive Power Techniques" (check http://www.ontariocolleges.ca/pdf/college_guide.pdf) cost approximately \$ 3000			
4. Recommended Pathway " Concentrated OYAP "	Concentrated OYAP is similar to the one-year certificate program at Mohawk above. Concentrated OYAP prepares you for academic success in the apprenticeship courses offered at College, in addition students may earn an exemption from the first of the three levels of Apprenticeship Training at College. Concentrated OYAP teachers will also assist you in finding a co-op placement that has the potential to become an apprenticeship.
