Other Pathways to Child and Youth Worker Certification				
1. Networking	If you have an employer willing to sign you for an apprenticeship, we may be able save you a registration fee and help your employer access funding to help reduce the cost of training. <b>See your guidance counsellor or co-op teacher and ask for a pre-registration form.</b>			
2. College Diploma Program	George Brown, Mohawk, Niagara and Sheridan all offer 3 year diploma programs (check also: <a href="http://www.ontariocolleges.ca/portal/page/portal/ONTCOL/FindProgram">http://www.ontariocolleges.ca/portal/page/portal/ONTCOL/FindProgram</a> for more details).

4. Apprenticeship	Mohawk College offers apprenticeship courses leading to possible certification as a Child and Youth Worker.			
5. CYW <b>Concentrated OYAP</b>	Requires Grade 12 college or university English. Concentrated OYAP students earn 4 secondary school co-op credits and 5 Mohawk College CYW courses in the same semester. If your employer agrees, you can pursue your CYW Certification through the Apprenticeship.
