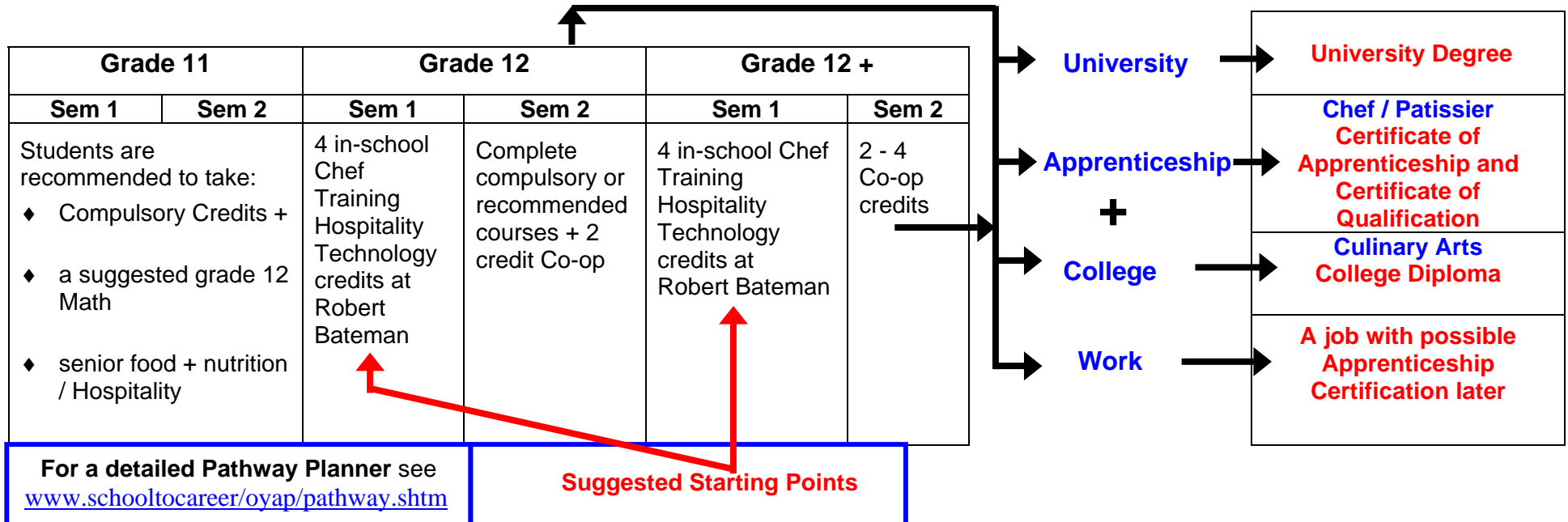


# Chef / Patissier, Cook / Baker Concentrated OYAP Pathways

<h2 style="text-align: center; color: red;">What is an Apprenticeship?</h2> <p>Apprenticeship is a form of post-secondary education in which students..</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• will earn while they learn.</li> <li>• will be taught one on one by a certified chef.</li> <li>• will be sent to take apprenticeship courses at college.</li> <li>• will have the government pay approximately 80% of the their tuition.</li> <li>• will have the opportunity to turn a blue collar job into a “gold” collar career.</li> </ul>	<h2 style="text-align: center; color: red;">Why consider Concentrated OYAP?</h2> <p>In Concentrated OYAP, students ...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• may shorten their apprenticeship.</li> <li>• may get their foot in the door with a potential employer.</li> <li>• may complete their first level of in-school apprenticeship training.</li> <li>• may save thousands of dollars on similar courses offered at colleges and private vocational training centres.</li> <li>• may still attend College or University if they have the entrance requirements.</li> </ul>	<h2 style="text-align: center; color: red;">What other training will I receive?</h2> <p style="color: blue;"><b>In the Chef / Patissier, Cook / Baker Concentrated OYAP</b></p> <p>students will have the opportunity to earn the following additional Certifications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Standard First Aid</li> <li>• Food Handlers Certification</li> <li>• Adult CPR</li> <li>• Young Worker Awareness</li> <li>• WHMIS</li> <li>• Passport to Safety</li> </ul>

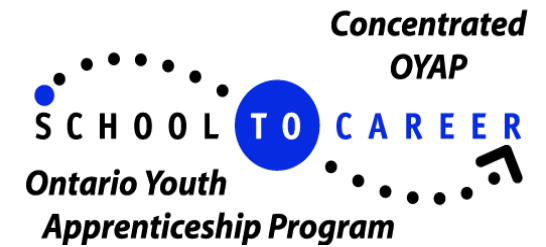

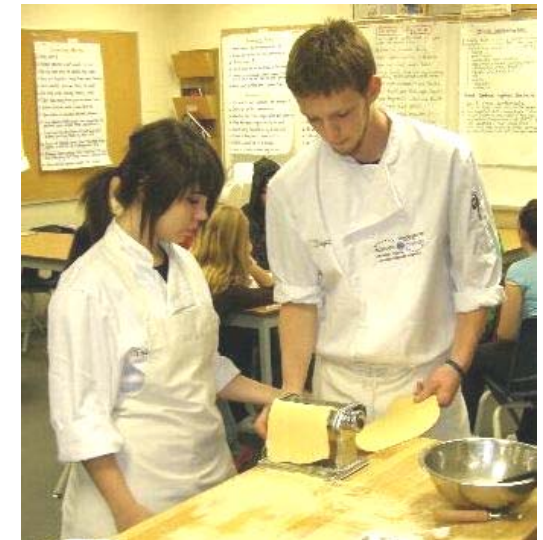
